**HAYLO** (Hilton Area Youth Lacrosse Organization) is a local non-profit lacrosse club, which currently offers organized team play at the 1-6 grade level. HAYLO competes outdoors with a Spring season and indoors with a Fall/Winter season. Roster size is limited and open spots vary depending on team. Roster space is open to Hilton School District students first. Our organization currently offers teams at the following level for the Spring outdoor season:  
**5-6 Grade Boys, 3-4 Grade Boys, 1-2Grade Boys, 5-6 Grade Girls & 3-4 Grade Girls.**

## REGISTRATION

**Existing HAYLO Players:** Registration is open from January 1, 2009 – February 10. All registration documents and payment should be mailed to HAYLO, 868 Whistlers Cove Lane, Rochester, NY 14612. All existing players are expected to register by mail. No further existing player registrations will be processed after 2-10-09.

**New Players:** Please e-mail us your contact info including child's name, grade and school attending. It is mandatory that we receive an e-mail from you so we can add you to the pre-registration wait list. You will be contacted via E-mail with regard to roster status. If there is room on the team you will be notified of the date and time for registration. The registration meeting will last for about 30 minutes with paperwork and equipment handout to follow. Your child should be attending this with you so that he can be fitted for equipment.

**PRACTICES-** Practices are held two evenings per week from 6 pm to 8 pm. Practices are held at the Hilton Village Park behind the Quest School on West Ave. Teams that list practice days TBD, and will be determined by the 3<sup>rd</sup> week in March.

**GAMES-** All games are held on Saturday mornings within the Monroe County area. All teams will play approximately 7 games plus tournaments, except the 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> Grade team that will play approximately 5 games. **COST-** \$125 per person. NEW players in the BOYS 3-6 Grade will be required to purchase a jersey. Jersey cost ranges from \$25-\$30. A sibling discount fee of \$25 will be given when two members of the same family belong to HAYLO.

**EQUIPMENT-** HAYLO has a loan program with all equipment available. There is a \$150 deposit due at registration and it is refunded upon return. Equipment will be handed out the night of the registration meeting. No equipment will be handed out until all registration paperwork and fees have been collected. **All returning players are required to supply their own stick and gloves. HAYLO lacrosse sticks will no longer be available thru the loan equipment handout process.** HAYLO will have a limited number of lacrosse sticks on sale for \$5.00 during the equipment loan handout / registration process.
