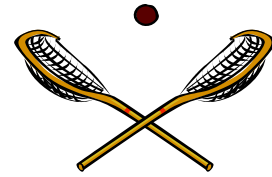

HAYLO (Hilton Area Youth Lacrosse Organization) is a local non-profit lacrosse club. HAYLO will offer a “House” BOX LACROSSE LEAGUE for boys in grades 3rd -6th.

LEAGUE STRUCTURE We will have 2 divisions/ BOYS 5-6^{grd} & BOYS 3-4^{grd}. Each division will have 4 teams of 9-12 players. This will be a competitive league with standings kept weekly. Play will be with box lacrosse goals and “modified” rules. This will be 5vs5 plus goalie field play. There are no off sides - players will run the entire field.

REGISTRATION

Existing Players: Registration is open from July 28-August 31st. All registration documents and payment should be mailed to Michelle Civiletti c/o HAYLO 296 Jonquil Lane, Rochester, NY 14612.

New Players: Please e-mail us your contact info: child’s name, grade and school attending. You will be contacted via E-mail with regard to roster status. If there is room on the team you will be notified of details for registration.

PRACTICES- Practices are held 1 evening per week. Practice dates are TBD and will be announced in late September with practices beginning in mid October.

GAMES- All games are played at the SALMON CREEK Indoor Complex. All teams will play a 12 game season beginning the first weekend in November. Games will be played on either Saturday evening anytime 6-8pm or Sunday anytime 1-3pm with an alternating schedule for each team.

COST- \$125 per person. A sibling discount fee of \$25 will be given when two members of the same family belongs to HAYLO. A customized Box Lacrosse reversible jersey/pinnie is included in the registration fee.

EQUIPMENT- HAYLO has a loan program with all equipment available for the players. There is a \$150 deposit due at registration and it is refunded upon return. Equipment will be handed out the night of the registration meeting. No equipment will be handed out until all registration paperwork and fees have been collected. **All returning players are required to supply their own stick and 5-6 grade players should have their own gloves.**
