- ❖ I will encourage good sportsmanship. I will set an example by demonstrating good sportsmanship and positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and other adults at all HAYLO functions which includes practices, games, tournaments and other related events.
- ❖ I will place the physical and emotional well being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win. **The game and events are for the children, not the adults.**
- ❖ I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- ❖ I will provide support for coaches and HAYLO staff working with my child to provide an enjoyable experience for all
- ❖ I will demand a drug, alcohol and tobacco free environment for my child and agree to refrain from their use at HAYLO events.
- ❖ I will require that my child treat other players, other teams, coaches, and adults with respect.
- ❖ I will treat other players, coaches, officials, other teams and adults with respect.
- ❖ I will require and assume responsibility for my player treating HAYLO equipment with care. I will assume financial responsibility for all lost or damaged equipment. I agree to return HAYLO equipment at the end of the season in a timely manner.
- ❖ **I will not recruit, solicit or encourage the recruitment or solicitation of players for the formulation of additional teams / organizations that would result in direct competition with the mission, structure of play and core principles of the HAYLO organization.**
- ❖ No persons other than players, coaches, officials are allowed on the same side of the field as the players. There are no exceptions. Please let the HAYLO coaches focus on coaching your children and allow your children to focus on directions from the coach. Please visit with your child before or after practice/game.

- ❖ All practices and games will be held as scheduled (rain or shine). You must attend all practices to participate in games, unless a school function/sport interferes. In this case, a phone call to the coach must be made.
- ❖ A full clean, uniform is required for all games. If you do not have a full, clean uniform at the start of the game, you cannot participate.
- ❖ You are responsible for all lost or damaged equipment. You are responsible for returning HAYLO equipment at the end of the season in a timely manner. Damage or misconduct of borrowed equipment will result in removal of the program. Please treat the equipment as if it were your own.
- ❖ Proper conduct will be shown at all HAYLO functions at all times. This includes no foul language, no fighting, no arguing, no disrespect to coaches, other teams or other players.
- ❖ You will display good sportsmanship at all times regardless of winning or losing.
