Directions: From 390 N – Travel 390N exit at Latta rd. Travel west (left turn) on Latta (RT18) travel west to the end of Latta rd. Turn right onto Manitou rd travel approx. ¼ mile turn left onto Parma Center rd (RT 18 cont). Travel approx 1 mile - you will enter the complex with a left turn onto a gravel rd. An additional entrance with parking (south entrance) can be located by traveling to the end of RT18 and making a left turn on RT 259. Enter at the second entrance to the park and follow the road to the back of the park. Everyone entering the park will receive a schedule and field map for all games.

When your team arrives at the Round Robin please check in at the registration tent with the **RED BALLOON**. We will need to confirm the following:

1. Roster / Parent Consent Form – each player can sign the same form
2. Team Registration Form

The 5th Annual Westside Round Robin will feature:

1. Referees – Experienced referees will be utilized to maintain consistency of play and enforce tournament rules.
2. Retail Vendors and “Custom designed” Round Robin event tee shirts available.
3. Raffles (2pm drawing) – We will feature numerous lacrosse and general merchandise items including our themed gift baskets. There will also be a 50/50 cash raffle.
4. Our very popular full service concession stand with an offering of various items. Sports drinks, soda and water will also be available.

PLEASE NOTE: Portable grills or cooking stoves are NOT allowed on the property.

The Westside Round Robin is organized for all of us to have fun with the great game of lacrosse. Supporting your team and teaching teamwork and sportsmanship to our children are our primary goals. For that reason, we do not keep score or award trophies. Each team will play three games.
